As Halifax continues to progress with its SolarCity project, solar thermal will receive unprecedented attention from not only other Nova Scotia municipalities but also from jurisdictions across North America. On April 17, Halifax council will be asked to approve the financial



commitment needed to launch the project. All other preparations are in place, including the submissions made on February 14, 2012 by the solar contractors hoping to lend their skills to the installation of systems in more than 500 homes in HRM.

Solar Nova Scotia has been working with HRM from the beginning and, of course, we are looking forward to seeing this project proceed. We are also continuing with our commitment on other fronts to make solar technology a part of everyday life in Nova Scotia. Public education through our construction courses, speaking engagements, media interviews, coordinating with the Nova Scotia Community College on course offerings, and expanding our on-line presence have all been priorities over the past 12 months.
